City of Westminster – Job Training Incentive Grant

- Will reimburse three types of training costs:
 - Custom classroom training at a public educational institution
 - Structured and documented on-the-job training (OJT)
 - A combination of classroom training and OJT
- Grant awards are capped at \$5,000, plus an additional 25%, or \$1,250, if hiring from a Westminster institution
- Qualifying industries include: manufacturing, technology, innovation, financial services, aerospace/defense and business support services
